Hey!

One of the amazing things about working at Leader Dog is witnessing the dedication that team members have to the organization and the mission. As in *decades* of dedication. About 30% of the team has been here 15 years or more!

One of the people who exemplified this commitment is Keith McGregor, who started working at Leader Dog back in 1981 as a dog care attendant. He then began his apprenticeship to become a guide dog mobility instructor. It was during that time that Keith recognized an unmet need for a program that served people who were both blind and deaf.

With Leader Dog's support, Keith enrolled in a local college program to learn American Sign Language (in case you didn't know, ASL can be signed by touching a person's hand, or "tactile signing"), and through his passion the groundbreaking DeafBlind Guide Dog program at Leader Dog was born.
